

Happy Fall, Y Members,

Every season brings with it things I look forward to at the Y, and things I'll miss from last season (bye, Camp!), and fall brings one of my all-time favorites: Youth in Government (YiG).

This program is designed for 7-12th graders to give them hands-on experience of democracy in action. YiG Counselors encourage kids to consider things they care about and wish worked a little differently or better in the world around them. Does that require a policy or law change at the state level? Then that's "their bill!" They spend a couple of months crafting a bill that they believe will make our communities and state a better place to live— and learning how to advocate for their position, ask thoughtful questions of others, and change their minds based on new insights or information. They practice debate with one another and other regional delegations, and take on different leadership roles based on what they've learned about the legislative process and their own personal strengths and interests. Then they take it on the road.

Our Manitowoc-Two Rivers YMCA delegation travels to Madison along with 150-200 young leaders from delegations across the state, and take over the Assembly floors at our State Capitol for a weekend in spring. They present their bills, listen, debate, vote, and see, first hand, the pathway from an idea to a state law. Not just see it— they create it! It is amazing, and as any Youth in Government young leader will tell you: it's a game-changer!

A huge thank you to our lead sponsor for this program, Susan Murtaugh, who has generously ensured that cost is not a barrier to learning and leadership!

There's a YiG Info Meeting on October 22nd @ 6 here at the Y. Hope to see you and/or your 7th-12th grader there! (Mine will be!)

P.S. As I write this on Wednesday, I received a phone notification saying "The US Government is officially shut down." If ever there was urgency in the need for Youth in Government, It. Is. Now. We have to do better and these kids absolutely will.
